AFFORDABLE SPAY NEUTER CLINIC

WE'RE ON OUR WAY TO MAKING A DIFFERENCE!

Happy New Year!! We are happy to start the new year with 2 spay/neuter clinics under our belt. The first one on Dec. 3rd, we spay/neutered 14 dogs and 9 cats! Wonderful! It went amazing for our first. Our second spay/neuter clinic was Dec. 17th and we spay/neutered 14 dogs, 10 of which were Pitbulls and 2 feral cats. Our volunteers worked great together as a team to make the short stay with us a wonderful experience for each and every animal. Many unwanted litters prevented!! On clinic days only we are also offering vaccines at very affordable prices. County, Camp Verde, Cottonwood licenses and micro chipping from 1pm -3:30pm. Morning Starr is working in a collaborative effort with Red Rose Inspiration for Animals and is offering FREE Spay/Neuter for Pitbulls and Pitbull mixes. The Spay/Neuter Pitbull program is generously sponsored by the Sedona Community Foundation along with funds from Red Rose. Let's see... can you do better than Free..ummmm. NO! Also ask us about our Morning Starr Litter Prevention Grant for Camp Verde residences. We offer Micro Chipping for dogs during regular office hours which are 8—12 noon Monday to Thursday and 8-12 noon on Friday. We are closed on Saturday and Sunday. You may also pick up your licenses during office hours too, with proof of Rabies. We are a non profit and are very appreciative of any donations to help pay for Veterinarian contracts, Vet Techs, medical equipment and things as simple as cotton balls to a new autoclave machine (which we need). You may sponsor a spay/neuter for someone too. Call for our price list and see how you can help. For a small donation we will trim dog nails too.

CHANCE'S STORY



Morning Starr Animal Sanctuary still has animals in our care. One of them was a wonderful dog named Chance. It has been about a month since he has passed but we wanted to share his story with you. Many of you have met Chance and loved those gold eyes of his. Chance was first seen by a cable worker who had a job site near where chance lived at the end of a 3 foot chain, day in and day out. The cable worker noticed that Chance had no water or food every day so she would share her lunch

and some of her water with him. One day she noticed that Chance was not able to put any weight on his back leg. She was very concerned so she call us at Morning Starr and asked if we could do something for Chance. We told her that we did not have any authority to take him but if the owner would agree to give him up we would take him in. She knocked on the door and told the owner that she had become fond of their dog and wondered if she could take him somewhere where he could get help for his leg. The owner said, "take him I was just going to kill him anyway." As soon as Chance arrived at Morning Starr we took him to the vet to see what happened to his leg. They said he was probably kicked and his leg was broken. They also noticed that there were some small round scars on his back. They said they had



seen that before and it was most likely cigarette burns. Well this story does have a happy ending. Chance lived out his years (13 years) with his dog, cat, horse, goat, rabbit, cow and people friends who he loved and loved him.
