

IT'S ALL IN THE NUMBERS

Here are our statistics so far. We have spayed/neutered 90 dogs and 24 cats. With our wonderful Grant from Sedona Community Foundation in collaboration with Red Rose Inspiration for Animals we have spayed/neutered 43 Pitbulls for FREE! We have had 9 spay neuter clinics since Dec. 3, 2012 when we first opened our doors. You may ask why is the number so low. Well we decided that from the beginning we would offer the best "State of the Art" equipment and almost one on one care for each animal that come for spay/neuter and never become an assembly line clinic. Also until we have our full time Veterinarian arrive next January we have only been able to contract out to other Vets, who are busy with their own practices, twice a month and sometimes only once a month. We are making a difference in the pet overpopulation for sure and we are doing it with great care and respect for the animals too. By spaying even one dog and one cat we are actually preventing thousands of future unwanted litters. This is only the beginning!



THE AUTOCLAVE FUND

We are saving for a new autoclave. That is a machine that is used for sterilizing the surgical tools and other things used for our spay neuter clinics. We do have one that is working though we are not sure for how long it will continue. Certain parts have already stopped working but nothing that would compromise the sterilization process. It is serving us well but we do really need one that is more dependable and not an antique. We have started a fund for saving for this autoclave and have had some wonderful donations towards the new unit. This graph shows how we have been saving for it through generous donations and hard work. We are almost there.
