OUR MISSION JUST KEEPS GETTING CLEARER!!

About 2.7 million healthy, adoptable cats and dogs, about one every 11 seconds, are killed in U.S. shelters every year. Often these animals are the offspring of cherished family pets. Many cats and dogs who die as a result of pet overpopulation could have made wonderful pets. The single most important thing that we can do to save cats and dogs from all the suffering and death that their overpopulation causes is to spay and neuter them.

For every homeless pet to have a home, each person would need to care for 7 animals! That means that a family of 4 would need 28 pets. There is a better solution. Spay and Neuter! A solution is possible and starts with each of us taking one small step, getting your own pets spayed or neutered.

Working in rescue for over 13 years I have seen the litters abandoned, surrendered and just plain abused. Morning Starr specialized in puppies and kittens under one month old. Many of you may have adopted a bottle fed baby from us. They just kept coming in! The answer is so clear to us and that is why we opened the Spay Neuter Clinic in Cottonwood.

We have spayed/neutered almost 200 dogs and cats, 120 of them being Pitbulls, which were done at no cost to the owners. It really does take a village as the "Pitty Party" project was started by Carolyn Bills & Sandy Macbeth, then Red Rose Inspiration for Animals in conjunction with Morning Starr received a Grant from the Sedona Community Foundation. Now Morning Starr has been granted funds again, along side Red Rose, to



continue the free Pitbull/Pitbull mixes spay/
neuter. For other breeds our prices are very
affordable and we are always willing to work
out payment arrangements for those who
need them. There is no excuse not to be

You must put in the time to make sure you dog is getting lots of exercise and mental stimulation. People call me wanting to give up their dogs for various behavior issues. I always ask, What do you do with your dog? Any training, or activities? They say, well he has lots of land to roam so



he gets lots of exercise. This is not the answer. The answer is spending time with the dog and teaching the dog to spend time as a family member in the house and learn the manners to do so. The thing that people have to realize is that the training classes are not really for the dog, THEY ARE FOR YOU! So join a class today!
