WHO IS MORNING STARR ANIMAL SANCTUARY?

Some of you are old friends that have followed us through the almost 19 years. Some have adopted rescued animals from us and some have volunteered for us. Many know us because we have assisted with spay/neuter or medical assistance. But some of you are new supporters. For you here is our story in a very condensed version.

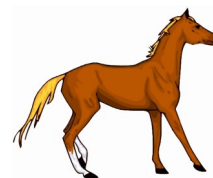
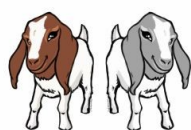
Morning Starr is a 501(c)(3) registered non profit. We began April 12, 2001 as a rescue for any and all types of animals needing refuge or help. We housed animals ranging from ferrets and bunnies to older horses, goats and even a very tall and stubborn Emu named Neil, that was found running loose on the highway. Liberty was a goat who walked on only two front legs. We began to focus on special needs animals and animals under one month old. We did a lot of bottle feeding, even to a 3 day old calf and many puppies and kittens.

We opened the Morning Star Spay/Neuter Clinic in 2012 and during our 6 1/2 years (we closed our clinic doors in June of 2018 due to personal health issues), we were able to assist or pay 100% of the spay neuter cost — depending on the pet owners situation. In that time we took care of over 1,300 dogs and cats.

Our Mission has always been — and remains — a focus and commitment to fulfill our goal to conquer the serious issue of an uncontrolled animal population.

Once the clinic was closed, we were strongly committed to carry on with our two new programs, The Act of Kindness for emergency medical treatment or medication and the Healthy Pet Project for spay/neuter.

Overpopulation of dogs and cats has been an enormous issue in the U.S. We are focusing on the Sedona and Verde Valley area to do our part to alleviate this problem.



IMPORTANT WARNING!

One of our emergency assistance was for a dog that ate a fish hook, along with the line. This resulted in a very expensive surgery and put the dog's life at risk. This event made me aware of the danger of taking your dogs to the river. Please check the area where your dog is playing to make sure it is free of any fish hooks and any other dangers.



DOG FRIENDLY OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS

Sometimes we can solve small problems (with dogs) with products that we may have around the house for ourselves. Here are some over the counter medications. We have consulted with a Veterinarian and he agreed that these may be used for dogs. Always ask your veterinarian before giving any medication to your dog. Even "safe" human meds can be toxic to certain breeds or pets with preexisting conditions.

BENEDRYL for Allergies and itching. 1 milligram per pound of dog.

DRAMAMINE for motion sickness. 12.5 milligrams for small dogs, 25 milligrams for medium dogs, 50 milligrams for large dogs.

BUFFERED ASPIRIN to relieve pain and inflammation. 1/2 baby aspirin for dogs under 10#, 1 baby aspirin for dogs 10-30#, 1/2 regular aspirin for dogs 30-50#, 1 regular aspirin for dogs 50-100#, 2 regular aspirin for dogs over 100#.

PEPTO BISMOL for diarrhea, vomiting and gas. 1 tea. Per 20#'s of dog weight (toxic to cats).

IMODIUM A-D for diarrhea. 1 milligram per pound of dog.

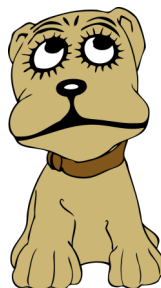
PEPCID AC (famotidine)/**ZANTAC** (Ranitidine) - to reduce stomach acids caused by ulcers, acid reflux or bellyache. 1/4 tablet for dogs under 20#, 1/2 tablet for dogs 20-60#, 1 tablet for dogs over 60#.

GAS-X to minimize flatulence or gas discomfort. 1/4 adult dose for small dogs, 1/2 adult dose for medium dogs, 1 adult dose for large dogs.

HYDROCORTISONE for itching or irritated skin. small amount applied topically up to twice daily.

HYDROGEN PEROXIDE used to induce vomiting after accidental ingestion of toxic substances. 10 Milliliters by mouth.

ROBITUSSIN DM for coughing or hacking- 1 tea. Per 10# of dogs weight.





ACT OF KINDNESS FUND EMERGENCY MEDICAL UPDATE

From July 2018 to May 2019 we were able to assist 48 pet owners with this fund. There have been various emergency situations such as badly infected teeth, an impaction, several uterine infections, injured limbs, attacks by javelin's or other animals, and euthanasia costs, to name a few. The fund expenditures for this time period were \$13,811.66, an average of \$1,315.00 per month. We did not receive a grant as applied for so this fund is still being funded by Morning Starr through donations from animals lovers like you! We have received \$660 in donations towards this program.

HEALTHY PET PROJECT SPAY/NEUTER ASSISTANCE UPDATE

From November 2018 through April 2019 we have assisted with 61 spays and neuters. The expenditures to date are \$5,857.04. In most situations, we have "split" the cost for these procedures. Due to some circumstances of the pet owners we have provided more assistance. In some cases, vaccines were included in the funds paid out. We have started assisting other rescues in the area also when requested.
